Entry Requirements

- Minimum of 3 years of work experience in delivering projects (optional)

Recognition of Prior Learning (education)

Depending on the student's current skills and experience student can qualify for Recognition of Prior Learning and be eligible for course acceleration.



Course delivery

The course can be completed in 12 months with a full-time study, load or in 24 months on a part-time study load and the minimum course enrolmentduration is one year.
